The citizens of Mohave County can expect the following road maintenance activity during the week of May 18th, 2026:

Arizona Strip: Road grading on **Mt. Dellanbaugh Rd.**

Kingman: Road grading on (1) **Topeka St.**, (2) **Pate Rd.**, (3) **Greasewood Rd.**, (4) **Falcon Valley Rd.**, (5) **Calle Ocampo**, (6) **Valley View Rd.**, (7) **Buckhorn Bend** and (8) **Jackrabbit Dr.** Repairing potholes and pulling road shoulders in the **Butler** and **Mohave Airport Industrial Park** area.

Valle Vista: Repairing potholes and pulling road shoulders in the **Valle Vista** Area.

Hualapai Mountain Area: Road grading on **Lazy YU.**

Yucca: Road grading on (1) **Coyote Wells Rd.** from Alamo Rd. to Signal Rd., (2) **Alamo Rd.** from Mile 11.5 to Mile 20 and (3) **Boriana Mine Rd.**

Hackberry: Road grading in **Greenwood Villages.**

Wikieup: Road grading on **Burro Creek Crossing Rd.** from Hwy 93 to Mile 14.

Golden Valley: Road grading on SE: (1) **Bacobi Rd.** from Crystal Dr. to Shinarump Dr. and (2) **Bolsa Dr.** from Bacobi Rd. to end of maintenance. S: (1) **Dawson Dr.** from Garnet Rd. to Jade Rd. and (2) **Volcanic Dr.** from Garnet Rd. to Topaz Rd. SW: **Redwall Dr.** from Egar Rd. to Dewey Rd. NE: **Marana Rd.** from Hwy 68 to Chino Dr. NW: **Elfrida Rd.** from Chino Dr. to Burro Dr.

Meadview: Road grading on (1) **Antares Rd.** from Mile 26 to Pierce Ferry Rd. and on (2) **Charles Dr.**

Dolan Springs: Road grading on (1) **First St.** from Ash Dr. to Becky Rd. and (2) **Thirteenth St.** from Pierce Ferry Rd. to Lomila Dr.

Mohave Valley: Road grading in (1) **Willow Valley** and (2) **Lagoon Estates.** Street sweeping in **Rancho Palo Verde**, crack sealing in **Sun Valley Estates**, pulling road shoulders on **County Route 1** and tree trimming in **Topock Lake Rancheros.**

Road Closure: I-40/US 93 Interchange Project:

Kingman: Clack Canyon Rd. from Longview Ave. to Anson Smith Rd. Road Closure will be present (Open to local traffic only)
