a) Concho Drive Speed Management

Valle Vista residents continue to express concern over traffic speeding and passing maneuvers on Concho Drive through the Valle Vista community.

Recommendation

Install 6-inch edge line delineating 10-foot travel lanes on Concho Drive, from State Route 66 to Painted Rock.

b) Safety Review of Frontage Road at Aztec Road

Evaluate the safety of the left turn movement from northbound Frontage Road onto Aztec Rd, located immediately southeast of the signalized intersection with SR 95. This study evaluates whether prohibiting the left turn movement at the subject location is appropriate based on MUTCD guidance and engineering judgment.

Recommendation

1. Install a No Left Turn (R3-2) sign, in conjunction with the existing stop sign at the near right corner of Frontage Road.
2. Install Destination (D1-1) signs along west side of Frontage Road reading “←Aztec Rd” positioned opposite the AutoZone access driveway and the southerly AZ Loans access driveway.

3. Install an Advance Street Name (D3-2) sign on SR 95 reading “Frontage Road → NEXT RIGHT” to replace the existing Right Turn sign, subject to ADOT approval.

c) Speed Study of Superstition Drive

A speed study was conducted on Superstition Drive from Route 66 to Mohave Road to determine an appropriate regulatory speed limit for the segment of the roadway. The evaluation included a geometric review of the curve and an analysis of operating speed data collected over multiple days.

Recommendation

1. Install a 35 MPH speed limit sign (R2-1) at the east end of Superstition Drive, immediately after vehicles turn off Route 66 onto westbound Superstition Drive.
2. Install a second 35 MPH speed limit sign (R2-1) east of the intersection with Mohave Drive, facing eastbound traffic leaving the neighborhood.
