

Truth in Taxation Hearing Notice of Tax Increase

In compliance with section 48-254, Arizona Revised Statutes, Mohave County Flood Control District is notifying its property taxpayers of Mohave County Flood Control District's intention to raise its secondary property taxes over last year's level. Mohave County Flood Control District is proposing an increase in the secondary property taxes of \$527,893 or 4.30%.

For example, the proposed tax increase will cause Mohave County Flood Control District's secondary property taxes on a \$100,000 home to be \$50.00. Without the proposed tax increase, the total taxes that would be owed on a \$100,000 home would have been \$47.94.

This proposed increase is exclusive of increased secondary property taxes received from new construction. The increase is also exclusive of any changes that may occur from property tax levies for voter-approved bonded indebtedness.

All interested citizens are invited to attend the public hearing on the tax increase that is scheduled to be held Monday, June 15, 2026 at 9:30 a.m. at the Mohave County Administration Building, 700 W. Beale Street, Kingman, Arizona.
