- RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the existing STOP sign be upgraded to an oversized 36-inch by 36-inch sign, reflective tape be installed on the existing STOP sign post, and a two-directional large arrow (W1-7) be posted at the E. King St. terminus.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This intersection is recommended to be converted into an all-way stop on bases of engineering findings under All-Way Stop Warrants C and E.

At the time of the All-Way Stop Sign installation, supplemental signing should be temporarily erected to warn of the new traffic pattern. In addition, each new stop sign is recommended to be given two red flags oriented 45 degrees from the vertical placed at the top of the stop signs.
