



# Overdose Data to Action Trainings

The following is a list of all educational trainings and presentations offered FREE of charge by the Overdose Data to Action program. These trainings are intended for group settings of 5 or more.

## Opioid & Fentanyl Epidemic ✓

This presentation gives you an inside look into the opioid epidemic and how the community can band together to make a difference. Attendees can expect to learn about opioids and addiction and examine data to see the impact on our community. Duration: 1 Hour

## The Dangers of Social Media ✓

Attendees will learn about ways in which youth may have access to dangerous substances via illegal social media transactions. This training is primarily intended for parents or those who work with youth. Duration: 1 Hour

## Naloxone Training ✓

Naloxone/Narcan is a fast-acting opioid overdose reversal medication. In this class, attendees will learn how to recognize an opioid overdose, how to administer Naloxone/Narcan, and more. Free kits are also provided at this training while supplies last. Duration: 30 Minutes

## Fentanyl: A Killer Among Us ✓

Students have the opportunity to learn about fentanyl and other opioids, overdoses and how they can help. "Fentanyl: A Killer Among Us" has been designed for youth, ages 12-17, and provides age-appropriate information on the dangers of counterfeit Fentanyl and other opioids. Duration: 1 Hour

## Operation Prevention Parenting Toolkit ✓

This is a four-part series that helps parents gain a better understanding of how opioids work, and the effects on the brain. Parents will also learn skills that can encourage healthy choices in their children, along with ways that they can help their children resist pressures. Duration: 4 classes, 1 hour each

## Safe Medication Practices for Life ✓

This presentation is designed to assist in medication management for those who might have multiple medications at home. You will learn about medication safety, safe disposal, and ways that you can advocate for yourself. Duration: 45 minutes to 1 Hour

## Rising Above the Opioid Epidemic ✓

In this training, attendees will use real-life scenarios to determine the best options to maintain a healthy lifestyle and rise above the opioid epidemic. This presentation will also discuss medication safety, overdose, and resisting pressure. Duration: 1 Hour

## Meth 2.0 ✓

This training will educate attendees about the dangers of the new meth, polysubstance use, current trends, and how we can help keep our communities safe. Duration: 45 Minutes
