This study evaluates all-way stop control at the intersection of Sandy Point Drive and Meadview Boulevard in response to reported sight distance concerns.

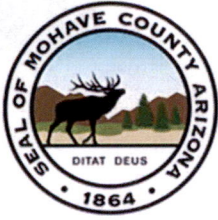
Recommendation

Maintain existing intersection traffic control. Improve intersection traffic control visibility through the following measures:

1. Install second STOP sign on westbound Meadview Boulevard approach on same post as existing R5-1 DO NOT ENTER sign.
2. If outside funds become available to cover at least 50% cost, replace existing R1-1 STOP sign on eastbound Meadview Boulevard approach with a solar-powered, LED flashing STOP sign on premise this approach has limited sign visibility.

1. Install second STOP sign on westbound Meadview Boulevard approach on same post as existing R5-1 DO NOT ENTER sign and upgrade both STOP signs to oversized signs

2. Install the following traffic control devices on eastbound Meadview Boulevard approach:

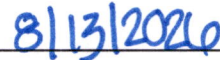
- Upgrade the existing STOP sign with an oversized STOP sign.
- Upgrade the existing STOP AHEAD sign with an oversized STOP AHEAD sign.
- Install STOP AHEAD pavement markings at the STOP AHEAD sign location.
- Install a STOP bar pavement marking at the STOP sign location.
